## St Michael's Parish, Berwick Order form for wall plaques



### **GENERAL RULES**

- Plaques will be 215mm X 65mm in size
- Plaques will be ordered using the standard form (see over)
- Plagues to be attached to the wall by an approved person
- Plaques limited to 5 lines or wording/symbols
- Maximum letters and spaces per line:
   30 for NAMES (large type counts as 2 lines)
   35 for normal text
- Plaques will be ordered by the Parish
- Plaques will be fixed to the wall outwardly from the central plaque
- Plaques may be ordered and prepaid anytime

It is not proposed to reserve bricks for spouses of plaque holders. A second plaque may be ordered later or the first plaque removed and replaced by a joint plaque subject to further payment.

Cash/Cheque/Credit Card in favour of St Michael's Parish to be enclosed with the order form.

Cost: \$300 which includes a levy for the upkeep of the wall
